

#### Yet Even Now...

I imagine that most of us do not have much familiarity with the book of Joel. An obscure Old Testament prophetic book just three chapters long, it is quite easy to overlook. Another reason we do not read from it much is that it is quite depressing. Judgment, doom and destruction are its primary themes.

But on Ash Wednesday, as we prepare our hearts for Lent, the season of accompanying Jesus to Jerusalem and eventually to the cross, we take time to sit with that darkness. To remember that we are from dust and to dust we shall return. And to remember that in our need and vulnerability there is a quiet strength that is hard to explain or describe. It is not a strength that comes from holding tighter, but one that comes from letting go.

Joel's word to the Israelites is that they have held on too tight to their own ways. They have strayed from the path, disaster is coming, and it is all of their own making. Three chapters of dark foreboding prophecy, softened by two phrases:

Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart. (Joel 2:12)

and

Who knows whether he will not turn and relent, and leave a blessing behind him. (Joel 2:14)

These phrases: "Yet even now" and "who knows," propel us into the Lent season, reminding us that even in our darkness, when we are sure there is no hope, no forgiveness, and no way out, God is always present. Blessings to you this Lent season. Do not be afraid to let go and sit in the darkness, for this present darkness will end in resurrection.
