
# REEDLEY RESIDENTS ALSO BENEFIT FROM THE GET MOVING CLASS!

## Alert but not Panicked

In a few weeks, our Sierra View Bible Study will conclude our fivemonth journey through the Gospel of Luke. Since we most frequently encounter the Gospel texts in bits and pieces throughout our lives, it is always good to take the time to read a Gospel from start to finish, and to ask the questions: "how has my understanding of Jesus been transformed?" "Where has my thinking been challenged?" "Where have new truths been revealed?"

One of the themes that emerged to me in a new way over the weeks spent studying this text was the urgency with which Jesus proclaimed the Kingdom of God. The inbreaking of the Kingdom was now, the end of all things could come to pass at any time, and there was no room to squeeze this new reality into the edges of your busy schedule. The Kingdom requires our full and immediate attention and the changes that will make to our lives as we know it will be drastic and often painful and uncomfortable.

It's not always easy to know what to do with some of these themes. 2000 years has taken an edge off of that urgency. Leave everything you have and follow me? Let the dead bury the dead? Who really is my mother and brothers? Jesus' words sometimes feel awfully drastic and perhaps even irresponsible!

Yet paired with that urgency is another instruction that occurs more than once: You are not to obsess over the day and the hour. These are words read again recently on Ascension Sunday. They are some of the last words Jesus speaks to his disciples.

There is a tension between the urgency of the Kingdom and the insistence not to obsess over when it arrives, and it is the balance between the two that we are called to live into. May our lives model the intentionality, sacrifice and attentiveness that anticipates and works for the Kingdom of God. And may we also hold onto things loosely enough to grant that in the end, all is held in God's capable hands.
