## HERE THEY COME AGAIN



January 1, 2024, is no exception when it comes to California and new laws to start the new year. As usual, some of the new rules will cause more concern for doing business in California. This year perhaps even more significant increases in costs for the state at a time when we know California is falling behind financially in their budget.

Three new laws specifically effect health care. The first one is a new minimum wage of \$16 per hour, an increase of \$1 from last January. In addition, as of June 1, a new law mandates a significant increase for all skilled nursing home personnel to at least \$21 per hour. Unfortunately, the unintended consequence of this new law dismisses any relevant benefits that an employee gets, it wipes away any seniority that an employee has and most importantly, it totally ignores any training, education, or skill level from one job category to another.

The other new law has more a stringent requirements for senior living facilities. We must have an alternative resource for electricity that can provide backup power for at least 96 hours.

#### WE MUST BE SPECIAL!

Two Mondays before Christmas at 8:00 am, five state licensing inspectors came to our front door to begin our Nursing Home Annual Certification Survey. For the next five days these surveyors poured through our residents records, both present and past; interviewed and questioned residents, family members, and staff; observed our procedures and care both individually and collectively; verified our maintenance and prevention to the detail. They checked our procedures against the volumes of Medicare and Medicaid rules and regulations.

Obviously the inspectors are there to look for deficiencies. The minor items found were not life threatening or serious, it was mostly documentation. Thank you to all the staff that show the care, the training, and concern for each of our residents each day.

Since the end of 2019, Sierra View Nursing Facility has experienced five state certification surveys. There are a number of nursing homes that have had far less, perhaps one or two. So given with this kind of oversight, we must be special.

# Rediscovering Epiphany



With all of the anticipation and celebration of the Christmas season, followed very quickly by New Years, it is very easy for us to stumble into the new year in a bit of a daze. It is well and good to slow down, take some time for ourselves, and commit to less sugar in our diets, but there is still one special day on the Christian calendar we often skip or overlook: Epiphany.
