Breaking the Cycle

In Genesis 37, when Joseph is still a teenager, he has a dream. In this dream he was binding sheaves of grain with his brothers and all of their sheaves bowed down to his. This did not sit well with his brothers.

Here we go again, more sibling strife and more division. It is a pattern throughout the book of Genesis. Cain murders his brother Abel, Abraham splits from his nephew Lot, Ishmael is sent into the wilderness to make space for Isaac who becomes the "legitimate" heir. Jacob deceives his brother Esau, and both families go their separate ways. And it is about to happen again. Except it does not.

Initially there is division. Joseph's brothers sell him into slavery. Joseph rises in the ranks of Pharaoh's household until the perfect scenario for retribution is served up. Cast them out Joseph, make them your slaves! It is what they deserve! You even had a dream to justify it!

But Joseph does not. This story will not end in division but in reconciliation. The next Pharaoh might make Joseph's brothers and their descendants slaves, but it will not be Joseph. Joseph steps up and breaks the cycle of strife and division. From now on, Israel and its twelve tribes will continue the story as one.

We too are born into families and cultures that carry the baggage of dysfunction and retribution. But it only takes one generation, one person to heal the family wounds and choose reconciliation. May we be the change we want to see in the world. May it start with us, and may it bless all who come after us.
